Border Print Placemat (Cindy Cockell)

I made these with a border print I had left over but they would also be nice with a feature fabric as the center. If your border print is a different height then just adjust the side border sizes to fit.

Border Print Center: 5 ½" x 10 ½" Yellow border: 1 ½" x wof Green border: 1 ½" x wof Purple border: 2 ½" x wof

Note: as long as you have 34" of the 3 border colors you will have enough

Corners: 4 squares 4 ½" x 4 ½"

Binding: 2 strips 2 ½"



- Sew the 3 border strips together and press. Square up one end. It should measure 4 ½" x wof
- Cut into the following lengths:
 - 2 strips 5 ½" for the sides
 - 2 strips 10 ½" for the top/bottom
- Sew the side borders to the border print. Press to the border print.
- Sew the corner squares to each end of the top/bottom border strips and press to the white
- Sew the top and bottom border strips to the center and press towards the yellow.
- Layer, quilt and bind. I did FMQ in the center and walking foot quilting in the rest. I did a stitch in the ditch on each side of the borders. I did a set of 6 of these and quilted each corner square differently. Have fun trying different quilting designs.
